

TWO BAYS VILLA & STUDIOS AT CABIER IN GRENADA

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to experience the Caribbean as it was 40 years ago before package tourism or cruise ships arrived? Is there anywhere left to stay in the Caribbean that does not cost a small fortune or where you do not have to share your beautiful beach with hundreds of other people? The answer is – Yes! – At Cabier in beautiful Grenada, the spice island of the Caribbean.

At Cabier there is total relaxation, it is a place where your dream of the Caribbean really can come true.



Where is it? Two Bays Villa and Studios are attached to Cabier Ocean Lodge, a small 11 room eco-hotel in Grenada. Cabier is situated on a promontory between two bays near where the Caribbean and the Atlantic meet.

It is described locally as “Grenada’s hidden treasure”. There are no other hotels nearby and it is in a completely natural environment, but with all the comforts that you might want. Cabier is about 45 minutes north of the airport and the capital St George’s, which is reckoned to be the most beautiful harbour in the Caribbean and gives access to great sailing in the Grenadine islands. Cabier is on the east coast 15 minutes south of Grenville.

ABOUT TWO BAYS

Two Bays Villa and Studios are on the promontory just above Cabier Ocean Lodge and are part of the little hotel. They are in a spectacular position with a backdrop of the interior hills and rainforest. The view from **Two Bays** is to Cabier beach on the left, Crochu bay and beach to the right, ahead of you there is a view out over the reef and out to sea.



Two Bays Villa, Bayside, and Beachside Studios have been furnished in a way that is elegantly simple, but caters for all your holiday needs. Sustainable hardwood has been used for doors, windows and furniture. Two Bays has been designed to maximise living space, removing the boundaries between indoor and outdoor living. There is no glass and all the windows and wide folding veranda doors have fully adjustable and lockable wooden louvres. They open 9 feet wide onto the large shaded verandas to take advantage of the view and sea breezes that are a feature of Cabier.

The Villa and each of the two large studios are self-contained with en-suite bathrooms and their own kitchens. The villa can be linked through double doors to each studio for a combination of 4 or 6 people. Beachside studio connects internally making it ideal for families as Beachside can be converted to 2 single 4 poster beds. These double doors are locked if separate guests are occupying the accommodation so the connection is sound proof, and they ensure privacy even when sharing with friends and family. Each of the three units has its own front door and the separate verandas do not overlook each other.

Two Bays sits 60 feet above the water catching the Cabier breeze off the sea. Each room has high ceilings, two large ceiling fans, with side fans in each bedroom. Air conditioning is available in the bedrooms if needed on the few occasions when nature is not doing its job. All the beds have mosquito nets. Average day time temperatures are 26 - 30 degrees. The Villa and Studios have good Wi-Fi access. The hotel reception, Bruno's restaurant, bar, and Cabier beach are 100 yards away.



At **Two Bays** you can choose when you wish to self-cater or eat out. The villa and studios are well equipped for self-catering. Each have a large fridge freezer, a four burner stove with oven and grill, microwave, toaster, coffee maker, kettle, and juicer, together with cooking utensils, pans, crockery, glasses and cutlery. Whenever you feel like eating out or a drink at the bar then, just a short stroll away, Bruno and Iris will be delighted to welcome you with excellent food and drink on the terrace at Bruno's peaceful and relaxed bar and restaurant that overlooks the ocean. Breakfast, light lunches and dinner are available. Bruno has built an enviable reputation on the island with his cooking, a mix of French, Creole, and Caribbean cuisine.

ACCOMMODATION DETAILS



Two Bays Villa has a 100 foot long, deep shaded veranda that wraps itself around the sitting room and the bedroom. Each room has two 9 foot wide openings with folding wooden doors, giving you outdoor living even when inside the villa. 180 degree views to the beach, bay and ocean from the veranda can be enjoyed from the double and single swing seats and easy chairs.

The 27 foot long sitting room has a sofa, easy chairs, and there is a dining table with chairs for 6 people on the veranda as well as large ceiling fans. At one end of the room there is a well equipped kitchen and breakfast bar. The large bedroom has a king size four poster bed with mosquito net, a hanging wardrobe and shelves with a room safe as well as two large ceiling fans and a wall fan. There is a full en-suite bathroom with shower, and hairdryer. It can also be accessed from the sitting room.



Two Bays Studios each have their own private 19 foot long shaded elevated verandas with swing seats, table and chairs, as well as a large wardrobe with shelves, room safe, full en-suite bathroom with shower, hairdryer and well equipped kitchen with a large fridge-freezer. Both have two large ceiling fans, a side fan, and air conditioning if needed. They both open out onto their verandas with 9 foot wide folding doors.

Bayside Studio overlooks Crochu Bay, beach, and ocean. It has a queen sized four poster bed with mosquito net.

Beachside Studio has a view from its veranda to Cabier beach and to the rainforest with Crochu village in the distance. It has a super king size bed or can have two single four poster beds with mosquito nets.

The large garden and infinity swimming pool with sun terrace is shared by both villa and studios (max 6 persons). There is a selection of comfortable garden furniture. Steps lead down to the road into Cabier Lodge with the path to the beach 100 yards away. There are two outside showers to wash off sand and salt after a swim. A car parking area with drying lines for towels and swimsuits is by the laundry area.

POOL AND BEACH

Cabier beach is a beautiful quarter of a mile long curving strand of firm white sand with nothing behind it except palm trees and the odd cow, goat, or donkey, usually with a couple of egrets in attendance. The offshore reef protects both bays, making Cabier great for safe swimming in the clear warm water and no current. Snorkelling is around the side of the bay inside the reef. Other than at weekends, when some of our locals come to the beach, Cabier guests will normally have it to themselves as in the photo below – rather like your own private beach.

The infinity pool and terrace is not overlooked and has great views over Crochu Bay and out to sea. Visiting bird life includes pelicans, large frigate birds and the occasional osprey.



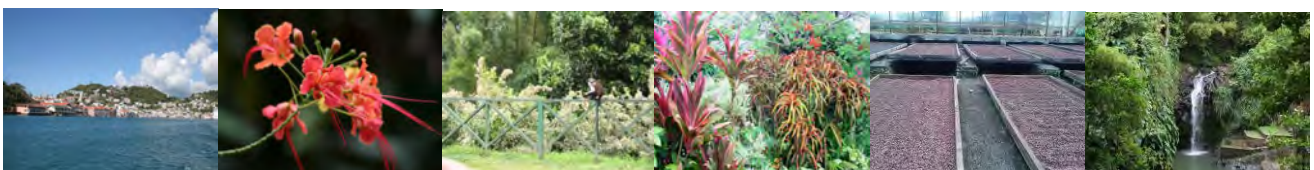
ACTIVITIES

There is easy walking along the headlands – Bruno can give you guidance on routes.

For those who are interested in more serious walking the Grenada rainforest is 30 minutes away with a wide range of colourful flora and fauna, birds, monkeys, and waterfalls with pools you can swim in. There are old rum distilleries and a chocolate plantation to visit. The interior of the island is spectacular with vibrant colours. The locals are friendly and a lot of the island has yet to be touched by tourism. You may even find a village cricket match to watch. Driving is on the left and easy half day trips will take you to what you want to see on any part of the island as we are halfway to most of the places to visit.

Even though you are supposed to be really chilling out and winding down Cabier style – the locals call it “limin” - you may be tempted to do a little inter – island visiting using the hydrofoil or the inter –island 6 seater plane up to the neighbouring Grenadine islands of Carriacou and Petite Martinique. Perhaps have a day in St George’s just wandering around the beautiful harbour with its shops, restaurants and market, and enjoying the historical aspects and views from Forts George and Frederick high above the harbour. Carnival is first week of August and there are regattas during January to March. Day sailing, snorkelling trips and diving are available on the island.

For anyone who fancies gently cruising through some of the 14 tiny islands that make up the Grenadines we can organise a **Sailing package** that combines your stay at Cabier with either 4 or 7 days on a yacht.



RATES & TRAVEL

Regular twice weekly flights by British Airways and Virgin from Gatwick, allowing for holiday combinations of 7, 10/11, and 14 nights. Prices change according to season. For North America the main airlines are American Airlines and Delta coming in from New York and Miami and Jet Blue and Air Canada coming in from Toronto. There are linking flights with LIAT from Barbados and Trinidad.

Two Bays prices are on the separate **downloadable Price List** on our website. Check on our website www.hamiltonholidayhouses.com and ask about our special offers, especially in Low Season where there is often an offer of stay 7 nights or more and have 1 night free. Two Bays is looked after by Cabier Ocean Lodge. All prices include full maid service every day. Linen, towels, and beach towels (provided) are changed every third day.

LIVING COSTS, BRUNO'S RESTAURANT AND BAR, AND GETTING OUT AND ABOUT

For exploring the island there is local jeep hire for a minimum of 3 days hire at around USD \$50 per day to be picked up at the airport or delivered to Cabier. We can organise for you in advance of your stay. Bruno also runs individual island tours from Cabier. Local minibuses to Grenville and St Georges are cheap as are taxis.

So having – we hope – seriously aroused your interest about coming to Two Bays and Cabier, we realise what can put people off going independently to the Caribbean is a concern about the cost of living when you are there. We thought the only way to address this concern is by example.

The advantage of Two Bays is that you can dip in and out of self catering whenever you want. But – ok so you do not want to cook when you are on holiday - what will it cost to eat and drink at Cabier's bar and restaurant? Dinner at Cabier is USD\$30 for 3 courses and a bottle of wine around USD\$27. A large rum punch or cocktail is around \$4-\$5 and a beer \$3. There are more details on our website about the cost of food in the markets etc.

You also have several other options. We can offer inclusive meal plan rates with Bruno's restaurant which cover either breakfast and dinner or dinner only and plans that include drinks with those two combinations. Bruno & Iris also offer massages in the pavilion overlooking the sea with a qualified masseuse.

Rates per night are room only and quoted in US\$ and include taxes

Two Bays Villa and Studios can be booked together for parties of 4-6 persons, whilst still retaining your own privacy. Request our special rates for combinations and longer stays.

The infinity swimming pool is for the exclusive use of guests of Two Bays. Maximum 6 persons

*A/C- Due to the cooling breezes at Cabier and ceiling fans in the rooms AC is not usually needed. If Required it is charged at \$5 USD per day. All beds have fine mesh mosquito nets.

Cabier Ocean Lodge and Two Bays Villa and Studios have free Wi-Fi.

Bookings

Cancellation and payment policy: 30% non- refundable deposit on booking.

Balance due 45 days before travel.

Cancellation within 45 days of travel – no refund

Payment is by credit card (plus 2%) or Paypal (plus 3%). Sterling payments possible for UK residents and euro payments for Eurozone residents at prevailing currency rate.

A rental car can be delivered to the Lodge or airport (min 3 days rental). Cost is between - USD\$45 - \$65 per day depending on season and vehicle. A local driving licence (ECD\$100) obtained locally through car hire company is necessary.

Taxi rates will increase according to the respective prices on the island. For a 45 minute airport transfer the booked Cabier taxi rate is around \$45 - \$50. The local taxi service can pick you up anywhere on the island.

Meals/tours/massages

Bruno's Restaurant and bar at Cabier Ocean Lodge provides breakfast, light lunches and dinner on a pre-booked basis (usually the night before or morning in case of lunch and dinner). All dietary requirements catered for.

Continental breakfast is USD\$11/Full breakfast USD\$15 per person. Set 3 course dinner is USD \$30 per person. Light lunch prices vary according to menu. Prices include service and taxes. Credit cards accepted. Bruno's restaurant bills guests separately at the end of their stay.
